Ms Annwyn Godwin, the Chief Executive Officer of the Independent Parliamentary Expenses Authority (IPEA). Ms Godwin's correspondence was in the form of a Requirement to Provide Information, pursuant to subsection 53(2) of the *Independent Parliamentary Expenses Authority Act 2017* (the Requirement). Having considered your correspondence, I am now writing to inform you that IPEA has concluded that you have not addressed or have not responded to significant elements of the Requirement. An assessment of your response against each of the six specified information requirements is as follows:

1. details of the accommodation in which each of yourself, your spouse and your two daughters resided on each of the nights of 21, 22 and 23 June 2019, including number of rooms booked at each establishment and when these bookings were made.

You have not provided this information. You supplied only a copy of a tax invoice from The Hotel Grand Chancellor for the night of Saturday 22 June 2019.

2. details of the dates, times and sessions at which you attended during proceedings of the Combined Meeting of RANZCO & ANZSOPS at the Hotel Grand Chancellor, Hobart, between 21 and 23 June 2019.

You have not provided this information. You supplied only a document indicating that you attended the RANZCO Tasmanian branch meeting on Sunday 23 June 2019.

- 3. details of your use of the hire car collected at Hobart Airport on 21 June 2019 and returned on 24 June 2019, specifically, other than travel within the city of Hobart:
 - a. destinations and routes of travel
 - b. dates and times of travel at which each journey was undertaken
 - c. drivers and passengers on each journey
 - d. locations at which you conducted inspections of Composite Fibre Technology structures

You have not provided this information.

4. an unedited complete copy, including header, of correspondence from Dr Nitin Verma AM confirming your attendance at the RANZCO Tasmanian branch meeting on Sunday 23 June 2019. You provided IPEA with an extract of such correspondence on 7 July 2021.

You have not provided the required document. Instead, you attached what you say is Dr Virma's initial Word document of 30 June 2021. I note that this document appears to have been created on Wednesday 1 December 2021. I also note that it is worded differently from the extract you provided to IPEA on 7 July 2021.

5. the name and contact details of the sponsor referred to in correspondence dated 18 May 2021 and 11 June 2021. On 18 May 2021, you advised IPEA "I was invited by a sponsor to attend the Congress to advance the electorate food hub proposal". On 11 June 2021, you advised that your attendance at the conclusion of the Gala dinner "was by arrangement with a Queensland sponsor at a time when formal presentations had concluded that evening".

6. names of persons who may confirm that you engaged with them at the Hort Connections Congress on the night of 26 June 2019 to advance the electorate food hub project.

You have not provided this information.





Requirement to Provide Information

I write pursuant to subsection 53(2) of the *Independent Parliamentary Expenses Authority Act 2017* (IPEA Act) to require you to provide information to the Independent Parliamentary Expenses Authority (IPEA).

Therefore, there are legal consequences if you do not provide the information as required in this notice. Section 53(4) of the IPEA Act provides that the maximum penalty for this offence is 30 penalty units (currently \$6,660).

Giving false or misleading information or providing false or misleading documentation to IPEA in compliance or purported compliance with a notice given under s53(2) are offences under s137.1 and s137.2 of the *Criminal Code*. These offences carry a maximum sentence of 12 months imprisonment.


